It is time to start seeking applicants for Rotary Scholarships. The following along with the information available on the Rotary web site contains most of the basic information needed. Keep in mind that students from your community attending schools outside District 6080 may apply through either your club or a club in the district where they attend school, although the application deadlines will be different in other districts. The form is not simple (20 pages) so potential applicants need to start work on their applications as soon as possible.

This application cycle will be for study beginning after July 1, 2005. Applications are now available on the Rotary International web site:

→ Go to www.rotary.org

→ Click on "Rotary Foundation" on the top bar.

→ Click on "Foundation Programs" (left side of page)

→ Click on "Ambassadorial (Peace) Scholarships" under Educational Programs.

There is a lot of information regarding eligibility and what the scholarships cover on that page. To get to the application forms, click on "Materials for Download" on the left side of that page. Applicants should also download the descriptive brochure.

→ Complete the application and submit it to a Rotary Club (students may submit applications through clubs in their home towns or where they are attending school). Clubs set their own deadlines, but for District 6080 clubs the completed and club-endorsed application must reach the scholarship chairman by April 1, 2004.

Selection interviews will be held April 17 (tentative) at the Grand Glaize Inn, Osage Beach. Applicants must attend the interview to be considered .

General eligibility criteria:

- Two years of college (strong transcript).
- Not be related to a Rotarian.
- Must study in a country outside the US.
- Capable of representing Rotary and the US before foreign audiences.
- Language fluency (for one year academic scholarships one must be

sufficiently fluent to do graduate work in the language of the study country.

- For cultural (language) scholarships one year of college level language study)
