Just Some Notes From Roger

I will be out of town on Wednesday to attend a superintendent's meeting in Farmington. During the month of September each year I travel around the state to eight regional meetings of superintendents to discuss current issues and the upcoming legislative session. I regret that some of these meetings fall on Wednesdays. **Steve Stark** has agreed to fill in for me during these times.

The Breakfast Rotary Board met on Thursday evening. The Board voted to offer an incentive for members to give to the Rotary Foundation. If a member donates \$800, the Breakfast Rotary will add \$100 and the Rotary district will add \$100 making the Rotarian a Paul Harris Fellow. If you are a sustaining member (donating at least \$25/quarter) and would like to become a Paul Harris Fellow, Breakfast Rotary will add \$100 to your donation to help you reach this goal. (For example, if you have donated \$600 to date to the Rotary Foundation, you can become a Paul Harris Fellow by donating \$300 and Breakfast Rotary will donate \$100 in your name.) These incentives are limited to a maximum of \$3,000 on the district level and \$1,000 on the local club level. So if you are interested, please take advantage of these incentives as soon as possible. More information on Wednesday.
