The preliminary application for the Rotary Youth Exchange Program is located on our website at www.rye6080.org. Click on the "Outbound" tab and select "Outbound Preliminary Application". (You might want to go on line and take a look at it so you know what information is required.) You should direct this student to fill out this application.

Attached are several documents that relate to the 2009-2010 exchange year. One is a "Fact Sheet" that provides a general explanation of the Outbound Program. Another is the "Flat Fee Chart" outlining what it will cost to participate in the program. And, finally, is a copy of the "Outbound Rules and Guidelines". I would encourage you to review these three documents, share them with your interested student and use them when promoting Rotary Youth Exchange in your community.

Once we receive the Preliminary Application, we will forward it to you so that you can schedule a time for the club level interview. At that time we will send you some additional information and a list of interview questions that we would like for you to ask.
