Club Presidents (and others),

Now that we have this year's group of Inbound and Outbound Youth Exchange Students settled in their respective homes, it is time to start all over again - asking Clubs to commit to hosting students in 2009-2010 and recruiting potential Outbounds. THE YOUTH EXCHANGE PROCESS NEVER ENDS!!!!

FIRST....NOW is the time to decide if your club might like to host an Inbound student next year. If you haven't hosted a student in recent years, we hope that you consider this wonderful opportunity to "enrich" your community by bringing an exchange student into your schools, homes and Rotary Clubs. I have attached the RYE Club Fact Sheet, which generally outlines what it takes to host an Inbound Student. I have also attached a Club Hosting Commitment Form which, if your club decides to host, needs to be signed by you, as the President of the Club, and returned via e-mail to both me and our District Secretary. This commitment is due no later than October

31st, though the sooner it is returned, the more likely we will be able to accommodate any preference your club might have. (In fact, I have already been contacted by two clubs that have requested students next year. :-)

SECOND.....It would be GREAT if all of you could try to identify a qualified candidate from your community to participate in the Outbound Program. The Rotary Youth Exchange Program is an incredible opportunity for a young person to live in another culture, learn another language and build bridges of friendship and understanding throughout the world. If you are able to find a student that is interested and qualified, please have him/her go to our Youth Exchange website at www.rye6080.org and fill out the preliminary application which is located in the Outbound section. (In fact, if you have a few minutes, YOU might want to take a look at this website, as it provides a wealth of information about the Youth Exchange Program.) Once we have received the preliminary application, we will provide instructions to both the student and to your club about what needs to be done next.

FINALLY.....I am going to be out of the country and will be "incommunicado" until October 10th. If you have any questions about the Outbound side of the Program during the next three weeks, please contact Chris Rice at chris_rice@sbcglobal.net. If you have questions about the Inbound side of the Program, contact Chris Young at inbound@rye6080.org. Both Chris and Chris would be happy to talk to you about the benefits of the Youth Exchange Program.

I REALLY hope that you and your club consider this opportunity to become involved in this INCREDIBLE Program. PLEASE bring it up at your next meeting!
